Executive Summary

The launch event of the European Chamber of Commerce in Saudi Arabia (ECCKSA) marked a historic milestone, establishing the first European Chamber in the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) and the broader Middle East region. Hosted in Riyadh on 8 May 2024, this significant event drew together 227 total attendees and 110 different company representatives from the European and Saudi business communities.

Key Highlights:

- **Historic Inauguration:** The establishment of the ECCKSA represents a pivotal moment in EU-Saudi relations, aimed at strengthening economic ties and fostering mutual growth and prosperity.
- Vision and Opportunity: Positioned in Saudi Arabia, a country with a dynamic economy and ambitious development goals under Vision 2030, the Chamber is uniquely placed to support and amplify European and Saudi business initiatives.
- Role of the Chamber: As a facilitator of deeper economic collaboration, the ECCKSA will play a crucial role in promoting European investments in key Saudi sectors such as tourism and business development. Additionally, it will assist Saudi companies in expanding their operations to European markets.

Organisational Support:

The ECCKSA's launch was backed by significant support from the Ministry of Investment of Saudi Arabia (MISA), the EU Delegation, and the EU-GCC Dialogue on Economic Diversification project, showcasing a strong commitment from both regional and European entities to the success of the Chamber.

Event Outcomes:

The discussions and presentations during the event highlighted the extensive opportunities for investment and collaboration facilitated by the ECCKSA, aligning with the strategic goals of Vision 2030 and the EU's foreign economic policies.

Presentation from ECCKSA by Mr. Kristijonas Gedvilas, CEO, ECCKSA

Introduction:

License & Constitution:

Official recognition and licensing by the Saudi Ministry of Investment and adoption of a Constitution for governance.

Building Relationships:

Ongoing engagement with Saudi ministries and authorities, and strong support from the EU Commission and Member States, positioning the ECCKSA as a pivotal business representative.

ECCKSA Services:

Introduction of services like Business Advocacy, Sectoral Committees, and various events to foster business relationships and address market challenges.

Summary for the Year Ahead:

Announcement of forthcoming programs and initiatives focusing on green transition, healthcare, and leadership, inviting more companies to join and form sector-specific committees.



Panel Discussion: ECCKSA - Shaping the Future of EU-KSA Business Collaboration

Growth of Saudi SMEs and Entrepreneurs:

The panel emphasized the ECCKSA's role in facilitating knowledge transfer and business best practices from European to Saudi companies. Initiatives like the garage innovation office in KAFD aim to stimulate local innovation and entrepreneurship by providing a platform for collaborative projects and learning from European business models.

Outward Direct Investment (ODI):

Discussion focused on the strategic importance of expanding Saudi Arabian products and services into European markets. The panel considered how ECCKSA could support Saudi businesses in sectors like energy and technology, which have significant potential for growth in Europe. This could involve facilitating partnerships, understanding market regulations, and enhancing Saudi presence in European trade expos and conventions.

One-Stop Information Hub:

The necessity for a centralized information resource was highlighted, where both existing and potential investors could find comprehensive data about market conditions, regulatory requirements, and investment opportunities in Saudi Arabia. MISA and ECCKSA were identified as key players in establishing this hub, which would simplify the process for businesses to engage with and invest in Saudi Arabia.

Strengthening Government Relations:

The panel underscored the importance of maintaining and enhancing open communication channels between the ECCKSA and Saudi governmental entities, including ministries and MISA. This relationship is crucial for aligning the chamber's activities with national priorities and ensuring that the business community's needs and concerns are effectively communicated and addressed in government policies and initiatives.

Articulation of Chamber Value:

It was noted that while some businesses are already benefitting from the ECCKSA's efforts, there remains a broader need to articulate the value and benefits of the chamber more clearly to the wider business community. This involves demonstrating how joining the chamber can enhance business opportunities, networking, advocacy, and influence in shaping business-related policies.
